<p>SCRAPBOOK</p> <p>Choose a character and create a collection of pictures that highlight scenes from your book. Include events that would be important to the character.</p>	<p>TELEVISION</p> <p>Box made to look like a TV with scene from book or screen that rolls through (scenes change). Must include at least 3 scenes.</p>	<p>STANDARDS</p> <p>~ RL1: Citing Text Evidence ~ RL2: Determining Theme ~ RI2: Determining Central Idea ~ SL4/SL5: Present Claims/Findings using Multimedia Components</p>	<p>COMIC BOOK PAGE</p> <p>Recreate your book as a comic.</p> <p>Be sure to include: - title and author - main characters, problem, and solution - speech & thought bubbles</p>
<p>CEREAL BOX</p> <p>Front of the box: Cereal Name, Picture of Cereal (cereal shape relates to the book). Right Side: List of characters with description, setting Left Side: Summary (includes main problem and solution) Back of the Box: Includes 2 games (games are based on the book) Top of the Box: Title, Author, Number of pages, Book Rating</p>			<p>* Each Report/Project can only be done one time *</p>
